

Power Supply Emergency Alert Notification System

Stay informed of possible outages

The Power Supply Emergency Alert Notification System now exists to inform utilities and the public about the possibility of power supply shortages within your area. Power supply markets extend across many states within the Midwest, and excessive power demand in any part of this region could result in limited power availability throughout the entire region.

Capital Electric Cooperative (CEC) receives power from two power supply markets. As you recall, some of our members experienced a blackout period in February 2021. In preparation for a possible re-occurrence of this situation, we will be providing an option for our members to receive notifications of these limited resource events.

You can receive email and/or text notifications using SmartHub, the online portal to your CEC account.
